Chairperson's Report (Alison French):

Again this year Community Council meetings and business has been greatly affected by the Coronavirus pandemic. All meetings this year have been virtual – but we would like to think that this has not prevented us from dealing with all of our usual business. We are hoping to be able to get back to face to face meetings soon.

This year the Community Council has again operated without a secretary and we have had 1 Community Councillor resign due to moving outwith the area. We are now running with only 5 active members out of a potential 10.

The Community Council has dealt with a number of issues since the last AGM including planning applications (including a retail development at Piperdam and a large solar farm at Berryhill), access to the Riverside recycling centre (ongoing from the precious year), winter maintenance issues & resilience, and attempting to get goalposts at Henderson Park in Liff, .

We have continued to see problems with speeding in our villages in addition to the temporary 20 MPH speed limits in Liff, Fowlis now has a 20 MPH speed limit. We are continuing to monitor whether we feel this has made any difference. There is also an ongoing discussion regarding speed on the road out of Muirhead towards Piperdam.

There has also been continued issues with parking at Birkhill Primary school and we have been having ongoing discussions with our community police to try to resolve these issues.

We also attended 2 joint community councils meetings which were hosted virtually by Angus Council. Following this we also took part in focus groups looking at winter maintenance and sustainable transport and discussions with Angus Council regarding the potential for help with minute taking for the Community Council.

Community Policing. PC Gail Beattie has not been able to attend due to meetings being held via zoom, but has provided us regular police reports.

The Community Council would like to thank the members of the Community Council, our local Councillors, local Police and members of the public who have attended our meetings, for their continued support of the Community Council.
